And Whereas, on the 14th day of July, 1960, Thelma Webb filed and recorded in Book 271 at Pages 197-201 in the Office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds of Sweetwater County, Wyoming, Protective Covenants covering the said lands known as the Paxton Webb Addition to the Town of Green River, Wyoming.

And Whereas, Thelma Webb on July 25, 1960, filed in the Office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds for Sweetwater County, Wyoming, Amendment to Protective Covenants recorded in Book 271 at Page 372 on July 25, 1960, and re-recorded in Book 283 at Pages 357-8 on May 26th, 1961, amending said protective covenants covering said lands.

And Whereas, since the filing and recording of said Protective Covenants and Amendment thereto by Thelma Webb, Robert H. Summers of Sweetwater County, Wyoming, and Union Congregational Church of Green River, a Wyoming Corporation, have acquired an interest in said lands or parcels thereof.

And Whereas, as the owners of said real property or holders of an interest therein they desire to amend and make additions to said Protective Covenants, reservations and restrictions on said lands for the benefit of themselves and future purchasers of said property.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, it is provided that the following described amendments and additions to said protective covenants, reservations and restrictions are placed upon said real property and every part thereof and said covenants, reservations and restrictions will run with said lands, and any and all conveyances of said lands, and every part thereof, shall be subject to the following covenants, reservations and restrictions herein set forth and any and all persons who shall hereafter acquire title to any of the above described lands shall take and hold the same subject to said covenants, reservations and restrictions as herein set forth, to wit:

- 1. Paragraph 3 of said Protective Covenants recorded at Page 198 in Book 271 in the Office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds of Sweetwater County, Wyoming, on July 14, 1960 is hereby amended to provide that no dwelling shall be permitted on Lots 1, 2, 3, 11 and 12 of Block 2 and on Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 19, 20, 21, 22 and 23 of Block 3, all of the Lots in Block 4 and 5, and on Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Block 6 may be of a cost of less than Nine Thousand Five Hundred and no/100 (\$9,500.00) Dollars and the minimum square feet thereof shall be not less than 900 square feet. It being expressly understood that the cost limits and minimum square feet area provided in Paragraph 3 shall not apply to the above enumerated lots.
- 2. Paragraph 11 recorded page 200 in Book 271 in the Office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds of Sweetwater County, Wyoming, on July 14, 1960, is hereby amended to provide that the Architectural Control Committee will be composed of Robert H. Summers, Jim Daniel, Hubert Hart and Jessica L. Longston.

The parties hereto, and each of them do hereby ratify affirm and approve the Protective Covenants, dated July 14, 1960,
